Made of Corian[®], with rounded edges and a thickness of just 4 mm, they convey a feeling of lightness and formal purity. They enhance the electrical system with touch solutions, traditional versions and versions dedicated to the hotel sector, showcasing all its functionalities. It's not just about design: Whitek 44 is designed to integrate with **wired home automation and IoT solutions**, offering intelligent functions aimed at **saving energy** and **creating green buildings**.

The ADA 2025 recognises AVE's dedication to innovation and design excellence, building on a legacy of blending aesthetics with technology. It's another triumph for the company and its award-winning Whitek 44 series, which has already won the Red Dot Award 2025 and the European Product Design Award.
